

Print Instructions

- 1) Print the "Card Faces" document from the deck of your choice on card stock or similar paper.
- 2) Once printing is complete, re-insert the stack of printed papers into your printer face-up (or otherwise in the manner that would result in the opposite side being printed upon). Then, print the "Card Backs" document.

Please bear in mind that most at-home printers will not perfectly align the print job on both sides of the paper. It is recommended that you do a test print of only one page to see how your printer aligns. If alignment is undesirable, or if you wish to save ink, you may leave the card backs un-printed.

- 3) Once printing is complete, cut out your cards. Cut the cards with the card faces up to ensure that no card text or card face edges are lost in the event of print misalignment.

You can cut out your cards by hand with scissors, using a professional paper cutter, or by using a razor blade/exacto knife and ruler on a cut-able surface such as cardboard or a kitchen cutting board. Please use caution when using sharp, open blades.
